

Rubric: Assignment – Glazing Process Reflection & Submission

This rubric uses a 4-point scale per criterion. Each criterion is weighted by percentage, and the weighted scores add up to 20 points total for the discussion.

Documentation of Process (25%)	Includes before & after photos and optional video link; documentation is thorough and clear. Reflection & Analysis (30%)	Thoughtful reflection (200–300 words or 2–3 min recording) with strong insight into choices, challenges, and outcomes.	Clear reflection with some insight; covers most required elements.	Basic reflection; limited detail or shallow analysis; missing one element.	Minimal reflection; lacks depth or missing multiple required elements.
Application of Technique (25%)	Glazing technique applied accurately with care; shows clear understanding of method.	Technique generally applied well with minor inconsistencies.	Technique applied inconsistently; visible issues or errors.	Technique poorly applied or missing.
Organization & Clarity (10%)	Submission is well- structured, polished, and easy to follow (includes transcript if using audio/video).	Mostly well- structured; minor clarity or formatting issues.	Somewhat disorganized or unclear; multiple formatting errors.	Disorganized and unclear; difficult to follow.
Submission Format & Guidelines (10%)	All components compiled in one file (PDF/DOCX/PPT/XLS /ZIP), submitted on time.	Submission mostly follows format and deadline with minor issues.	Format inconsistencies or late submission.	Submission incomplete, wrong format, or very late.



Available points: 20

Scoring Guide:

- 20 pts = Exceeds expectations
- 15–19 pts = Meets expectations
- 10–14 pts = Approaching expectations
- 9 pts or below = Needs improvement

4-point scale (Level of Performance)

- 4 = Exemplary
- 3 = Proficient
- 2 = Developing
- 1 = Needs Improvement

Criteria weight of total grade:

- Documentation of Process = 5 points (25% of 20) max.
- Reflection & Analysis = 6 points (30% of 20) max.
- Application of Technique = 5 points (25% of 20) max.
- Organization & Clarity = 2 points (10% of 20) max.
- Submission Format & Guidelines = 2 points (10% of 20) max.

Conversion and total score

Level of performance score / max level of performance score * total points for that criteria = X total points for that criteria

Add all total points for all criteria to get the total score out of 20.
